The Reward of Seeking: Satisfaction

You satisfy me more than the richest feast. I will praise you with songs of joy.

Psalm 63:5 (NLT)



Prayer Focus: This statements of David's comes after his statement that He had seen the Lord's Glory in the Santucary. The realization of our seeking the Face of God, is that we see His Glory. And when we see His Glory, we realize that He satisfies more completely than anything this world could offer. David uses the analogy of food here... "you satisfy me more than the richest feast." Solomon echoes these sentiments throughout the book of Proverbs, often using the illustration of gems, and riches. Whatever the analogy, the reality is that only in the personal, intimate knowledge of who God truly is, do we find true satisfaction. We live lives that are constant reminders of how the world never quite satisfies us. Whether is it in possessions, or power, or relationships, we are always left just a little bit short without the knowledge of the person of God. This true satisfaction only comes to those who seek Him, until they see Him in His sanctuary. Do not allow yourself to settle for anything less than God Himself. Only He will bring true satisfaction to your life. Continue to seek the Face of God and do not give up.

- Day 1:** Today, think about those things that you look to for satisfaction in your life. How many of those are rooted in the Person of God? How many in the world?
- Day 2:** Confess to the Lord today, those areas of your life where you have looked for satisfaction to things other than God.
- Day 3:** Tell the Lord your determination to seek His Face and see His Glory in His sanctuary.
- Day 4:** Ask the Lord to help you and your family to find their satisfaction in the person and character of God rather than earthly possessions.
- Day 5:** Pray today for the leaders of your church to know how to guide your church into seeking God and finding that only He satisfies.
- Day 6:** Pray for other believes in your city to find this same truth, that in God's presence is true satisfaction.
- Day 7:** Pray for the missionaries of your church to live and teach that God alone satisfies our every need.
