The Reward of Seeking: Wisdom

Teach us to realize the brevity of life, so that we may grow in wisdom.

Psalm 90:12 (NLT)



Prayer Focus: Wisdom is the God given ability to understand the Scriptures, and to apply them to every circumstance of life. In our seeking the Face of God, and in His glorious Presence, we will be able as Moses asked here in this verse, to understand the brevity of our lives, and apply godly wisdom in a correct manner that will allow us to live lives of godly wisdom in this world. The world is full of human foolishness, and does not understand the value of godly wisdom. As the people of God, who seek His Face, we need Him to fill us with the wisdom that comes from His Word, and applied by His Holy Spirit. Only then will we be able to navigate the dangerous roads that lie before us. The Scriptures are full of examples of the contrast between those who rely on earthly, human wisdom, and those who are filled with godly wisdom. One of the results of seeking the Face of God and dwelling in His presence is being filled with His wisdom. Let us not lose sight of this goal for our lives as we continue to press on to seek the Face of God.

- Day 1:** Evaluate your life today. In how many areas of your life are you relying on the wisdom of the world, or human wisdom rather than the wisdom of God?
- Day 2:** Pray today the prayer of Psalm 90:12, and ask the Lord to help you number your days to apply wisdom to your journey.
- Day 3:** Wisdom is found in the Scriptures and applied by the Holy Spirit. Commit yourself anew today to be a faithful student of the Word of God.
- Day 4:** Pray today that your family will diligently seek the Face of God and learn wisdom from Him.
- Day 5:** Lift up in prayer your church leaders. Ask the Lord to give them godly wisdom as they shepherd the church under their care.
- Day 6:** Pray also for other pastors in your city to have the wisdom of God for their churches, and families.
- Day 7:** Pray for the missionaries of your church to be filled with godly wisdom for the work of God's kingdom.
