The Year of Sowing – Honor – At the Marriage Supper

Let us be glad and rejoice, and let us give honor to him. For the time has come for the wedding feast of the Lamb, and his bride has prepared herself.

Revelation 19:7 (NLT)



Prayer Focus: We close this section on honor with the great hope of the Church, the Marriage Supper of the Lamb. That time when the Church, the Bride of Christ is finally united with her Bridegroom. Throughout the age of the Church, the great expectation is for that time when the Bride will finally be united with her Bridegroom, never to be separated forever. This verse describes the heart of the Bride of Christ... “let us be glad and rejoice, and let us give honor to him.” Honor begins and ends with Jesus. When the Church is gathered at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, our concerns will not be for how others treated us or who did whatever it was that we didn’t like. Our sentiment will be that of rejoicing and giving honor to the one who redeemed us and caused us to sit with Him at His wedding feast table. For all eternity we will honor Him for redeeming us, and He will honor us by giving us a seat at that great Wedding Feast. Are your eyes on that day? Are you living in the glorious hope that someday you will join the saints to gather with our Bridegroom and Savior? How would your lifestyle change if you would begin today to live your life in light of that glorious day? What would change if you knew that all the cares of this world will melt away in the light of the glorious presence of our Holy Bridegroom? Examine your life today. Are you ready, if He were to call us today? Are you carrying burdens that keep you from looking forward to that day? Begin today to live your life in light of this grand and glorious truth of Scripture... we will be glad and rejoice and give honor to Him at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.

Day 1: Search your heart today. Are you truly living in light of the Marriage Supper of the Lamb?

Day 2: Ask the Lord to forgive you for ways you have lost sight of this glorious hope.

Day 3: Implore the Spirit of God to transform your heart so that you begin now to live a life of joy and rejoicing and honoring Him.

Day 4: Pray that your family would learn the joy of this hope that is set before us. Teach your children this glorious truth.

Day 5: Pray for your church leaders to teach this truth as the Lord leads to give hope to the saints.

Day 6: Pray for the other churches in your city to be revived to this glorious hope of the Marriage Supper.

Day 7: Pray that your missionaries would teach this as well and find courage to continue their ministries in light of this truth.
