Week 11

The Year of Harvest – Water of Life

The Spirit and the bride say, “Come.” Let anyone who hears this say, “Come.” Let anyone who is thirsty come. Let anyone who desires drink freely from the water of life.

Revelation 22:17 (NLT)



Prayer Focus: The water of life is a term used only here in revelation chapters 21 and 22. But the term “living water” is a term that is used by Jeremiah in Jeremiah 2:13, and 17:13, where the Lord describes Himself as the fountain of living water. This living water or water of life is a description of the very life of God for His people. Jeremiah describes how the people had abandoned Him as the fountain of living water. God calls that an “evil thing” that the people had done. They turned away from the Lord for other things. In Revelation 22:17, Jesus offers this water of life to anyone who desires and they may drink freely of this water. The Lord Himself is our water of life. When receive the finished work of Christ on the cross for our sins and repent and turn to Him, He says that we not only receive His life, but that this life of God will flow from our own lives to others. Just as water is essential for our life and survival, so is the life of God essential for us who believe. For us to be productive, and victorious in this world, we must constantly be filled with the life of God, and allowing that life of God to flow out from us to those, like the woman at the well in John 4, who need this life giving water. What an amazing truth, that God himself offers us His life to live within us. What grace and mercy are a part of this offer of the water of life from our loving and holy God.

Day 1: Read the passages in Jeremiah and Revelation, and meditate on what these verses are saying.

Day 2: Take time today to thank the Lord for being the water of life, the living water for your life.

Day 3: Ask the Lord to teach you how to live in His life, and allow His life to flow from you to others.

Day 4: Pray that the river of living water would flow through your family. That the life of God would be your life and joy today.

Day 5: Pray that your church would be full of the living water, the life of God in all your activities.

Day 6: Pray that the living water would unite the churches in your city to flow together to reach many with His life.

Day 7: Pray that the missionaries from your church to have this living water of God’s life to empower and encourage them.
