The Year of Harvest – Life from the Throne

Then the angel showed me a river with the water of life, clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb. It flowed down the center of the main street. On each side of the river grew a tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, with a fresh crop each month. The leaves were used for medicine to heal the nations.

Revelation 22:1-2 (NLT)



Prayer Focus: We have seen that the Throne of God is the source of this water of life, and that this water is the source of life and blessing. But let us look this week at the fact that the water and this life flows from the Throne. The throne is a symbol of authority. It represents the rule and authority of the King. Here it is the rule and authority of God and the Lamb who is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. The water of life flows from the place where the Lord is enthroned as king. In our lives, if Jesus is not on the throne of our lives, the river of life giving water cannot flow freely from us to be a blessing to others. It cannot give the life it is intended to impart to us and to the world. We cannot have sin in our lives and expect to have the water of life flow from us. James speaks of this in James 3:11 when he says: *Does a spring of water bubble out with both fresh water and bitter water?* The water of life flows from the heart, from the life where Jesus is enthroned as the King of your life. He is to be King over every area of your life. When King Jesus rules in our lives, then the water of life flows freely. It is a result of the Life of God, by the Holy Spirit living and flowing through our lives. When Jesus is King in our lives, His Kingdom becomes a blessing to others, and the water of life brings healing and blessing to those around us. Is Jesus King over your life today? Have you allowed Him to rule over every area of your life?

Day 1: Ask the Lord if there are areas in your life today where He is not on the throne of your life.

Day 2: Give praise to the Lord today that He desires to be the King on the throne of your life. Praise Him as your King.

Day 3: Today, purposefully place the Lord Jesus Christ as King over every area of your life. Confess every sin that would prevent Him from sitting on the throne of your life.

Day 4: Pray together that the Lord Jesus would be the King over your family.

Day 5: Pray that Jesus would be the King on the throne of your church.

Day 6: Pray that other churches in your city would put Jesus on the throne of the life of their church.

Day 7: Pray for the missionaries from your church not to lose sight of this important truth in their lives.
