### Week 18

#### The Year of Harvest – Choosing the Door

*“You can enter God’s Kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide for the many who choose that way. But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it.*

#### Matthew 7:13-14 (NLT)



**Prayer Focus:** In Revelation 4, John describes a door that is open in heaven. John entered the glories of heaven through that door. A door is not a destination in itself. A door is a means of getting from one place to another different place. In order to enter into the glories of heaven we must enter through the correct door. Here Jesus says that there is one door through which we enter into the Kingdom of heaven. There are those in our world that would say that there are many doors, and many ways of entering into eternal life and into heaven. But Jesus calls this the broad way that leads to hell. Many choose this way because they refuse to accept the truth that Jesus is the only door into eternal life. But Jesus states in these verses that you can only enter God’s Kingdom through the narrow gate, the narrow door. Jesus is the door, and it is through Him that we enter into the Kingdom of God, and into eternal life. The greatest challenge in life is choosing the correct door. Have you chosen to enter through the narrow door into eternal life? Or is your life still on the broad road to destruction. If you are a believer in Jesus, then you also have the responsibility to help others find the correct door that leads to eternal life. Jesus is the door to eternal life and all who choose to enter will have life with Him forevermore. Which door will you choose? Are you helping others choose the door to eternal life?

- Day 1:** Take time to meditate on what it means that Jesus alone is the door to eternal life.
- Day 2:** Thank the Lord today that He has made a way through this death for you to have eternal life.
- Day 3:** Pray for those that you know who have not yet chosen to enter the door into the Kingdom of God.
- Day 4:** Pray for any of your family members that need to choose the narrow way to eternal life.
- Day 5:** Pray that your church will be strong and clear in calling people to faith in Jesus as the only door to eternal life.
- Day 6:** Pray the other churches in your city to be clear in the proclamation that Jesus is the only door to the Kingdom of God.
- Day 7:** Pray for the missionaries from your church to have freedom to proclaim Jesus as the only door to eternal life.
