### The Year of Harvest – The Fruit of Our Dreams

*“Look!” he said. “The people are united, and they all speak the same language. After this, nothing they set out to do will be impossible for them!”*

#### Genesis 11:6 (NLT)



**Prayer Focus:** When man was created, God said that He made man after His own image, in His own likeness. We mirror in more ways than we realize the character and personhood of God. One of those reflections of the character of God is creativity. God, we all understand, is an infinitely creative being. Just look at a garden of flowers or take a walk through the forest and you see the result of the creativity of God. In Genesis 11:6, God expressed that there is built within man an almost limitless fountain of creativity. This idea is communicated in the Hebrew word “Yatsar” which means to create and has the idea of to imagine, to have the conception of thought of something. It has the idea of having plans and purposes formed in the mind. This is the idea behind our dreaming, our ability to create something from a concept in our minds. In Isaiah 46:10, God states that He sees the end, or imagines the end result and the beginning of a thing. God has given us the ability to dream. Now sin has twisted and distorted that ability, but under the direction of the Holy Spirit in the believer, we can be led and directed by the Holy Spirit to dream of amazing and wonderful things. Today many educational and medical institutions are the result of believers who dreamed something and made it happen. We have airplanes and spaceships, lightbulbs and telephones, all the fruit of someone’s dreams. What dreams would God want to put into your mind to bring glory to His Name? Don’t be afraid to dream for God.

**Day 1:** Take time to think about things in your life, things around you that are the result of dreaming.

**Day 2:** Are there dreams in your heart that you have given up on because of discouragement or weariness?

**Day 3:** Listen for the Lord to speak to you about dreams that He might have for you to accomplish.

**Day 4:** If God has given you a dream, ask Him to lead you in how to accomplish that thing. Remember, it does not have to be huge, maybe a dream for your family, or your church.

**Day 5:** Pray that people in your church would have freedom under the guidance of the Holy Spirit to dream dreams for the Kingdom of God and His glory.

**Day 6:** Pray for creative ways of discipleship and outreach to come out of other churches in your city.

**Day 7:** Pray that your missionaries would dream creative ways to share the gospel around the world.
