The Year of Harvest – Year end Reflections – Finances

Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful.

1 Corinthians 4:2 (NKJV)



Prayer Focus: The second theme in this year of harvest was in the area of Finances. The Bible teaches us that how we use the resources that God gives to us is a reflection of our relationship with Him, and how we understand Him. Being useful for God.” The glorious truth is that each of us has been given unique gifts and callings so that we can serve the Lord for the Glory of His Name, and the advance of His Kingdom. God promises to provide for us as we seek first His Kingdom (Matthew 6:33). This includes the area of finances, which in many ways is the hardest area for the people of God to understand. The eternal truth of giving, and reaping, few have come to understand in its fullness. We tend to hold on tightly to what we have because we do not understand the truth of stewardship. But this stewardship is a principle of the Kingdom of God...what we sow in finances will be returned and multiplied to us. But we must learn to adopt a different mindset about our finances. The world tells us to hoard and save and guard. The Kingdom truth tells us that if we hold on and guard what we have, we will lose it. One of the most difficult and yet one of the most rewarding of these principles of sowing and reaping. Examine your life today. Are you being a faithful steward of the finances that God has so graciously placed into your care? They are not yours, they are Gods and He has entrusted them to you. Are you faithfully sowing, so that you will reap the reward He promises?

Day 1: Use this day to be open to the Lord and let Him examine your life in the area of finances.

Day 2: Confess any ways that the Lord may have spoken to you or challenged you in this area.

Day 3: Commit yourself to be a faithful steward of all the resources and gifts the Lord give to you.

Day 4: Pray as a family that you would be examples of a faithful family in your stewardship.

Day 5: Pray for the Lord to challenge other believers in your city in this area of stewardship.

Day 6: Pray that the leaders in other churches would teach true Biblical stewardship to their people.

Day 7: Pray that the missionaries you know would be shining examples to those they serve of faithful stewards.
